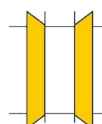

### Mili Doshi

*MBE, BDS (Hons), MSc (Special Care Dentistry and Sedation)*

Mili qualified from Guy's Hospital in 2001 and is a Consultant in Special Care Dentistry at Surrey and Sussex Health Care NHS Trust and the Royal Hospital for Neuro-disability. Mili has always been very committed to dental training and improving oral health services for adults with disabilities. Mili has a special interest in sedation and general anaesthesia in Special Care dentistry. In 2015, Mili developed the Health Education England national initiative 'Mouth Care Matters' to improve the oral health of adults in hospitals that was rolled out across England. Mili is the past president of the British Society of Gerodontology and is the current chair. She is the author of several articles in peer-reviewed journals and is the editor of a book on the oral health of older people. Mili was awarded an MBE in 2018 for her service to NHS dentistry.



### Yvonne Rooney

*B.Dent.Sc. (Hons), DPDS, MSc, MSCD RCSEd*

Yvonne qualified from Trinity College Dublin in 2008. She is a Consultant in the Department of Sedation and Special Care Dentistry, Guy's and St. Thomas' NHS Foundation Trust, London. Yvonne completed her specialty training having worked across community and hospital dental services. In 2015 she completed a Masters in Sedation and Special Care Dentistry with King's College London (KCL). Her MSc project investigated methods of diagnosing dental pain in patients with moderate to severe dementia, and her continued research interest is the oral health of older people. Yvonne provides training in special care dentistry and conscious sedation to undergraduate and postgraduate dentists at KCL. She is the Treasurer for the British Society of Gerodontology, and Chair for the Special Care Dentistry Managed Clinical Network for London.
